

Announcement for the open position of Assistant Professorship

Tokyo Institute of Technology, School of Environment and Society

1. Position: Assistant Professor (one person)

(A term of within five years, only once reappointment of within five years. Annual Salary system. Salary will be determined according to the National University Corporation Tokyo Institute of Technology Salary Regulations for Employees with Annual Salary.)

2. Division: School of Environment and Society, Tokyo Institute of Technology

3. Research Field: Architectural Design, Architectural History, Architectural and Urban Planning

4. Requirements: Applicants should have a remarkable achievement in the above-mentioned fields. It is best to hold or be expected to obtain a Doctoral degree or PhD. Teaching duties are likely to comprise the above-mentioned fields for undergraduate and graduate students. Applicants should have the ability to be in charge of architectural design studio and descriptive geometry, and put into practice of the above teaching in not only English but also Japanese.

5. Expected Start Date: Position becomes available on 1st April 2018 (at the beginning of the Japanese academic year)

6. Deadline of Application: 5:00 PM (JST) on 25th September 2017

7. Documents to be submitted:

- 1) Curriculum vitae (since graduation from high school), full postal and email addresses, names of all academic degrees with dates awarded, outline of professional career, record of membership and activity in relevant academic societies.
- 2) Full and comprehensive list classified into architectural design works, academic papers, books, articles, and any other relevant professional works, as educational and social activities, prizes/ awards etc. H-index and citation number should be described if possible
- 3) Copies of five significant works, papers, or articles (in either Japanese or English, mark ‘*’ in the list defined in 2)).
- 4) Brief statement of research and teaching interests/ achievements, regarding the applicant’s past career as well as his/ her future perspectives and goals (within 2 pages).
- 5) Contact information of reference person, including name, affiliation, e-mail address.
